Citizen of the United States sole owner of the Schooner vessel called the *Oliver Bulver* of Buffalo whereof James K. Davison is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner vessel was built at Rochester, N. Y. in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this port, dated August 6. 1866 and numbered 185.

Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and 2 masts, and that her length is 139 feet her breadth 26 feet her depth 11 feet her height and that she measures 204 tons and 94 hundredths,
