In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that Michael Carr resided at the same place, and that they are

sole owners of the Lug Propeller vessel called the J. L. Swift  
of Buffalo, whereof Michael Carr  
is at present Master, and as he hath sworn  
is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Lug Propeller vessel  
was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1859, as appears by the  
Certificate of her last Enrollment at this port,  
dated Sept 21, 1865, and Numbered 255. Now  
surrendered having changed Owners.

that her length is 57 feet
