sole owners of the Propeller vessel called the Dean Richmond of Buffalo whereof R. L. Kolvin is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller vessel was built at Cleveland, O. in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated June 26, 1865 and numbered 218, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and that her length is 226 feet her breadth 34 feet her depth 21 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 1416 tons and 42 hundredths,
