In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Lewis E. Williams having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Racine, Wis. and that he is the Agent of Jonathan R. Brearly, Elias J. Ritchard, and Richard Williams, who each own One third (1/3), of said Schooner, and that they are

Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the M. M. Arbuckle of Racine whereof Lewis E. Williams is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Erie, Pa. in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 25, 1866, and Numbered 82.

Now surrendered having changed Owners & District and said Enrollment. Having certified that

the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 90 feet her breadth 23 feet her depth 9 feet her height 9 feet and that she measures 125 tons and 81 hundredths,
