is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at Rochester, N. Y. in the year 1860, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Oswego, N. Y. dated Sept. 11, 1865, and numbered 553

Now surrendered having changed Owners & District and said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 94 feet her breadth 17 feet her depth 8 feet her height 2 feet and that she measures 108 tons and 96 hundredths,
