Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Pamlico, of Buffalo whereof David Mc Cormick is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago, Ill. dated April 2, 1868, and Numbered 264, now surrendered vessel having arrived at her Home Port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 127 feet, her breadth 26 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet and that she measures 379 tons and 71 hundredths,
