is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Cleveland, O. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Oct 28, 1865, and Numbered 296, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barge or vessel has One deck and three masts, and that her length is 185 feet, her breadth 24 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet and that she measures 542 tons and 24 hundredths,
