Blake is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Sug Prop.* or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated August 4, 1866, and Numbered 184.
