sole owner of the *Schooner* or vessel called the *Stafford* of *Cleveland* whereof *Wm Murray* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Schooner* or vessel was built at *Lorain* in the year 1868, as appears by *the Certificate of Parsons & Humble, shipwrights her builders, dated June 4, 1868. On file in this Office.*

And *Alonso H. Scriven Surveyor* having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *112* feet her breadth *25* feet her depth *9* feet her height *10* feet and that she measures *199* tons and *91* hundredths,
