is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at Lockport, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Brooklyn, N. Y. dated July 15, 1867, & numbered 62.

Now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 95 feet her breadth 17 feet her depth 8 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 118 tons and 14 hundredths,
