In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1804, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Y. in the year 1868, as appears by the Certificate of Geo. H. Kotter, shipwright her builder, dated July 25, 1868. On file in this Office.

And Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Lug Propeller or vessel has ~~no~~ deck and ~~no~~ mast, and that her length is 70 feet her breadth 15 feet her depth 7 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 29 tons and 02 hundredths,
