Cheyne is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Sept. 2, 1865, and numbered 317.

Now surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrollment. having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and that her length is 184 feet her breadth 27 feet her depth 11 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 688 tons and 94 hundredths,
