In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and that *Mary A. Bruce* resides at the same place, and each own One fourth (1/4), and that *Robert Anderson* resides at Cleveland, Ohio, and owns One fourth (1/4), and that *Alexander Stewart* resides at Chicago Ill. owns One eighth (1/8) and that *Mrs Kate L. Bruce* resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and owns One eighth (1/8) and they are

sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the *Champion* of Buffalo whereof *Alex. Stewart* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 25, 1868, and numbered 272.

Now surrendered having changed Owner. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and 2 masts and that her length is 182 feet her breadth 32 feet her depth 12 feet and that she measures 585 tons and 59 hundredths,
