Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of *Toledo, Ohio* dated *September 5, 1868* & numbered *174*. Now surrendered, vessel having arrived at her Home Port and said Enrollment, having certified that

the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *one* mast, and that her length is *167* feet her breadth *34* feet her depth *15* feet her height *10* feet and that she measures *499* tons and *28* hundredths,
