McAlpin is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Cleveland O. in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Detroit, Mich. dated July 21, 1866 and Numbered 218.
