In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

sole owners of the Barge or vessel called the Forrest King of Buffalo whereof H. C. Stark is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated October 2, 1868, and Numbered 61.

Now surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrollment Having certified that the said Barge or vessel has One deck and 2 masts and that her length is 160 feet her breadth 28 feet her depth 9 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 345 tons and 46 hundredths,
