Citizen of the United States sole owner of the Propeller or vessel called the Danestes of Buffalo whereof He No Drake is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Dunkirk, N. Y. dated April 6, 1865, renumbered 1. Now surrendered having changed Owners District. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has Deck and Mast, and that her length is 135 feet her breadth 27 feet her depth 11 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 856 tons and 07 hundredths,
