Lothridge is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 1, 1865, and Numbered 241.

Now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrollment, having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 94 feet her breadth 17 feet her depth 7 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 106 tons and 41 hundredths,
