Y. in the year 1861, as appears by her last Enrollment at this Port, dated August 2, 1865, and numbered 284. The Certificate of which has been lost at appears by the affidavits of R. H. Beckwith on file in this Office.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 95 feet 2/10 her breadth 17 feet 5/10 her depth 8 feet 6/10 her height 10 feet and that she measures 116 tons and 57 hundredths,
