Gibson is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Huron, Ohio in the year 1852, as appears by her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 18, 1868, and numbered 265, the Certificate of which has

been lost, as appears by the Affidavit of Thomas Farnham and said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 123 feet her breadth 28 feet her depth 9 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 25 1/2 tons and 25 hundredths,
