In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1804, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Hiram H. Smith, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is the Attorney of Mildred Smith who resides at the same place, and that she is a

Citizen of the United States sole owner of the Brig or vessel called the Helfenstein of Buffalo whereof Alex. Haack is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or vessel was built at Milwaukee, Wis. in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 27, 1849, and Numbered 120. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is 130 feet her breadth 26 feet her depth 12 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 281 tons and 40 hundredths,
