In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

John H. Montgomery having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N.Y.* and owns *Seven Twelve (7/12)*, and that *Edward Hason* resides at the same place, and owns *Five Twelve (5/12)*, and that they are

John H. Montgomery Citizen of the United States sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the *Eli Bates* of *Buffalo* whereof *J. K. Murray* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at *Erie, Penna* in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated *April 1, 1867*, and numbered *25*.

Now surrendered having changed Owner, and said Enrollment. I having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts, and that her length is *25* feet her breadth *25* feet her depth *10* feet her height *10* feet and that she measures *264* tons and *91* hundredths,
