PORT OF BUFFALO.

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States.

Mathias Gardner, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that Nicholas Delfer resides at the same place, and that they are

each one half part Citizen of the United States sole owners of the Canal Boat vessel called the Dock Pierce of Buffalo whereof Mathias Gardner is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at Lockport, N. Y. in the year 1863, as appears by her last Enrollment at this Port, dated June 29, 1867, and numbered 218. The Certificate of which has been lost as appears by the Affidavit of Mathias Gardner and said Enrollment.

Having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 95 feet her breadth 17 feet her depth 8 feet her height 10 feet

and that she measures 124 tons and 22 hundredths,
