John C. Clifford, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns Seven Twentieths (7/20), and that James J. Hayden resides at the same place, and owns Seven Twentieths (7/20) and that Fred. Davis resides at Portland, Me. and owns Six Twentieths (6/20), and that they are

Citizens of the United States sole owner of the Lug Prop. or vessel called the J. J. Hayden of Buffalo whereof Am. H. Morgan is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Lug Prop. or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1868, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Sept. 5, 1868, and Numbered 40.
