Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Mary Ann Rankin of Buffalo whereof Charles M. Kinsky is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Charlotte, N. Y. in the year 1857, as appears by Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 13, 1868 and Numbered 12, 1868

Now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is 91 feet her breadth 20 feet her depth 8 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 110 tons and 84 hundredths,
