Y. in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 4. 1867, and Numbered 79.

Now surrendered having changed Owners And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and One mast, and that her length is 182 feet her breadth 21 feet her depth 10 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 887 tons and 42 hundredths,
