In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Stephen D. Baldwin having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y., and that he is Vice President of "The Union Steamboat Co" and that he is a

Managing Citizen of the United States sole owner of the Propeller or vessel called the Toledo of Buffalo whereof H. A. Lison is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Cleveland, O. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 1<sup>st</sup> 1865 and numbered 125.

Now surrendered having changed Owner. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and that her length is 179 feet her breadth 21 feet her depth 10 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 792 tons and 25 hundredths,
