In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Bartholomew Mc Cabe having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and that Charles Jeterman, and James Berry reside at the same place, and that they are

each one third part Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Imperial of Buffalo whereof John Mc Lennan is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Jan. 21, 1866, and Numbered 5.

Now surrendered having changed Owner, and said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts, and

that her length is 125 feet her breadth 30 feet her depth 11 feet and that she measures 299 tons and 29 hundredths,
