Y.* in the year *1864* as appears by *the certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Oct 15, 1866, numbered 264* the certificate of which has been lost as appears by *And said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Boat* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *No.* Mast and that her length is *73* feet, her breadth is *17* feet, her depth *4* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *51* Tons and *08* hundredths, viz:
