# ENROLLMENT.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

*Adam Homer*

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and owns *One third (1/3)* and that *A. R. Tracy* and *J. H. Herpicks* reside at *New York*, and each own *One third (1/3)*, and that they are

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Boat* or Vessel called *Janie No. 2. Herpicks* of *Buffalo* whereof *Adam Homer* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Boat*, or Vessel was built at *Rochester, N. Y.* in the year *1866* as appears by *her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 20, 1867, renumbered 257.* The certificate of which has been lost as appears by the affidavit of *Adam Homer* And said Enrollment.

having certified that the said *Boat* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *No.* Mast and that her length is *94* feet, her breadth is *17* feet, her depth *11* feet, her height *10* feet,

and that she measures *149* Tons and *66* hundredths, viz:

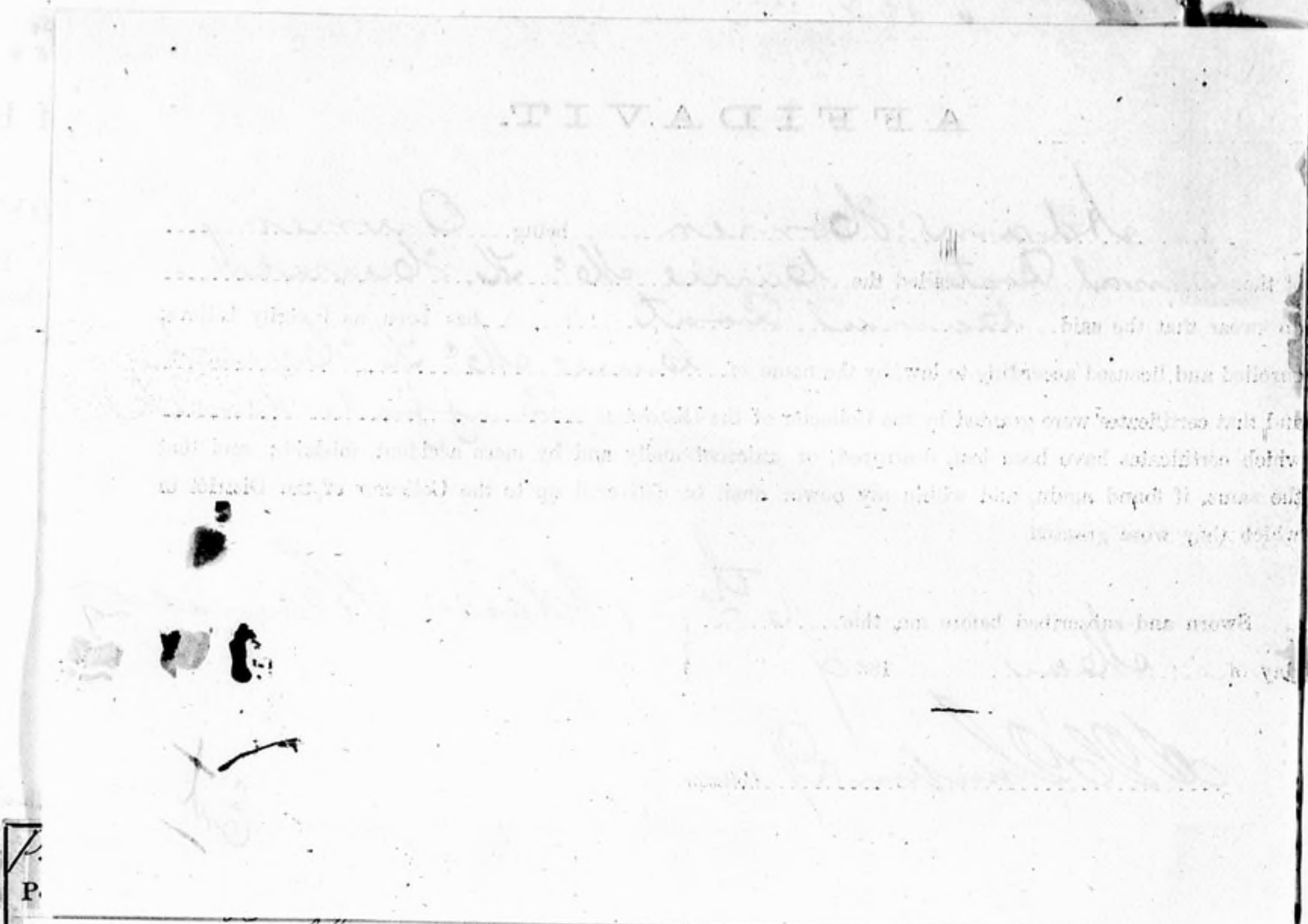
