is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller Vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio* in the year *1864* as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 29, 1865 numbered 170. Now surrendered having changed Owners.* And said Enrollment

having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has *two* Decks and *One* Mast and that her length is *187* feet, her breadth is *28* feet, her depth is *11* feet, her height is *10* feet, and that she measures *766* Tons and *28* hundredths, viz:
