having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and that he is *Vice President of the Union Steamboat Company,* and that he is a

citizen of the United States, *sole* owner of the Propeller Vessel called *Equinox* of *Buffalo* whereof *H. B. Archer* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller Vessel was built at *Buffalo, N. Y.* in the year *1857*, as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 4, 1867, and Numbered 80.* Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller Vessel has *two* Deck and *One* Mast and that her length is *187* feet, her breadth is *30* feet, her depth is *10* feet, her height is *10* feet, and that she measures *870* Tons and *51* hundredths, viz:
