having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns One fourth (1/4) and that Mary Richmond executrix of the estate of the late Dean Richmond, residing at Patawig, N. Y. and owns Three fourths (3/4), and that they are

citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Propeller Vessel called Mountain City of Buffalo whereof Geo. Perkins is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1857 as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago, Ill., dated April 22, 1869, Numbered 246, now surrendered, vessel having arrived at her home And said Enrollment having certified

that the said Propeller Vessel has 2 Deck and No Mast and that her length is 210 feet, her breadth is 30 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet,
