Y.* in the year *1869* as appears by *the Certificate of Abelom Nelson, Shipwright her builder, on file in this Office.*

And *Alonzo H. Lewin, Surveyor,* having certified that the said *Canal Boat* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *No.* Mast and that her length is *95* feet, her breadth is *17* feet, her depth is *7* feet, her height is *10* feet, and that she measures
