ENROLLMENT.

District of Buffalo Creek, Port of Buffalo.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Henry B. Kinslow

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is attorney of H. J. Kinslow of New York, who owns one half (1/2) and R. L. Kinslow of Cleveland, Ohio owns three eighths (3/8) and that David Mc Cormick of Buffalo, N. Y. owns one eighth (1/8) and that they are

citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner Vessel called King Fisher of Buffalo whereof David Mc Cormick is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1867 as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago Ill dated May 2, 1869 & numbered 262 now surrendered, vessel having arrived at her home port.

And said Enrollment having certified

that the said Schooner Vessel has One Deck and three Masts and that her length is 165 feet, her breadth is 22 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet,

and that she measures 517 Tons and 22 hundredths, viz :
