Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Hiram H. Smith

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is Attorney of George F. Weaver of Albany, N. Y. who is a

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner Vessel called Ketta Weaver of Buffalo whereof Charles Kelly is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the

said Schooner Vessel was built at Toledo, Ohio in the year 1864 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 9, 1868 and Numbered 292. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that

her length is 127 feet,

her breadth is 26 feet,

her depth 10 feet,

her height 10 feet,

and that she measures 210, Tons and 19 hundredths, viz:
