Boat* or Vessel was built at *North Bay, N. Y.* in the year 1868 as appears by *the certificate of J. H. Hollenbeck, shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.*

And *Alonzo H. Leuven, Surveyor* having certified that the said *Co. Boat* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *No* Mast and that her length is *95* <sup>8</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet, her breadth is *17* <sup>7</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet, her depth *8* <sup>6</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet, her height *8* <sup>10</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet, and that she measures *122* Tons and *35* hundredths, viz:
