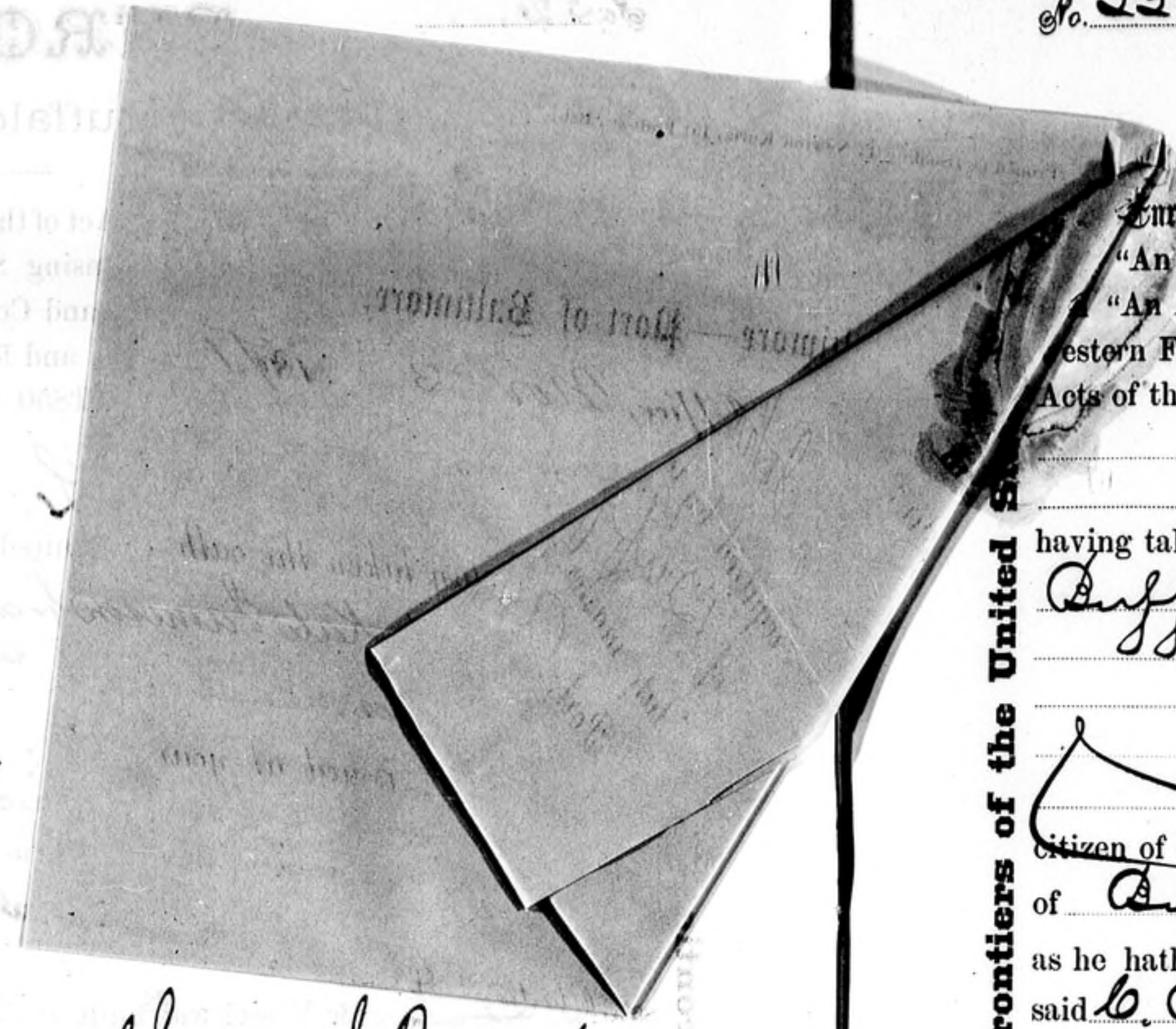
AFFIDAVIT.
