is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Boat or Vessel was built at Durhamville, N. Y. in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of Wm & Kitter, shipwright her builder. On file in this Office.

And Alonso S. Seriven, Surveyor having certified that the said Boat or Vessel has One Deck and No Mast and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth is 17 feet, her depth is 6 feet, her height is 10 feet,

and that she measures 88 Tons and 29 hundredths, viz:
