And A. H. Seriven, Surveyor having certified that the said Coast or Vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is 93 feet, her breadth is 17 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 125 Tons and 70 hundredths, viz:
