having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that she resides at *Buffalo, N.Y. and that she is a*

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called *Kewsbay* of *Buffalo* whereof *J. J. H. Brown* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at *East Saginaw, Mich* in the year *1862* as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated Sept 14, 1866, and numbered 218. Now surrendered having been altered from a Sloop to*
