Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and North-western Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Q. L. Kims

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and owns *three fourths (3/4)*, and *that Mrs. Sarah E. Kims resides at the same place, and owns One fourth (1/4) and that they are*

citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* Vessel called *Sam Flint* of *Buffalo* whereof *James J. Candon* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn *James J. Candon* is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Schooner* or Vessel was built at *Toledo, Ohio* in the year *1868*.

as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Sept 9, 1868, and Numbered 44* *now surrendered having changed Owners*.

her length is *167* $\frac{7}{10}$ feet,

her breadth is *24* $\frac{1}{10}$ feet,

her depth *15* $\frac{0}{10}$ feet,

her height $\frac{0}{10}$ feet,

and that she measures
