Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

James A. Chard, having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y., and that he is a

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Sloop or Vessel called A. B. Cornell of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop or Vessel was built at Ithaca, N. Y., in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Aug 19, 1867, and numbered 280. Now surrendered having changed Owner.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Sloop or Vessel has One Deck and No. Mast and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth is 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet,

and that she measures 114 Tons and 58 hundredths, viz:
