said Schooner or Vessel was built at *Buffalo, N. Y.* in the year 18*53*

as appears by *the Certificate of her late Enrollment at*

this Port, dated April 21, 1864 and Numbered 146.

Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And *said Enrollment* having certified

that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck and two* Masts and that

her length is *119* feet,

her breadth is *25* feet,

her depth is *10* feet,

her height is *10* feet,

and that she measures

216 Tons and *92* hundredths, viz:
