Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Henry M. Barker,

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y., and that he is a

citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Boat or Vessel called Dudley Reed of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Boat or Vessel was built at Phoenix, N. Y. in the year 1868 as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Oswego, N. Y., dated Aug 11, 1868 & numbered 141, now surrendered having changed Owners & District.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Boat or Vessel has One Deck and No Mast and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth is 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height — feet, and that she measures 125 Tons and — hundredths, viz:
