Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Boat or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1861, as appears by her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Nov 14, 1865, numbered 408. The certificate of which has been lost, as appears by the oath of A. L. Lothridge on file in this Office.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Boat or Vessel has One Deck and No Mast and that her length is 96 feet, her breadth is 17 feet, her depth is 7 feet, and that she measures
