ENROLLMENT.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

John H. Montgomery, having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns one half (1/2) and that Edward Herson resides at the same place, and owns one third (1/3), and that Timothy McEwen resides at Lockport, N. Y. and owns one sixth (1/6) and that they are citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called Eli Bates of Buffalo whereof Timothy McEwen is at present Master, and as he hath sworn that he is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Erie, Pa. in the year 1857 as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 12, 1869, and Numbered 125, now surrendered having changed Owners, and said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is 135 feet, her breadth is 25 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 264 Tons and 91 hundredths, viz:
