citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Schooner* or Vessel called *C. P. Williams* of *Buffalo* whereof *he* is at present Master, and

as he hath sworn *he* is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Schooner* or Vessel was built at *Michigan City, Ind.* in the year 1853 as appears by *the certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Sept 12, 1869 & numbered 61.*

 And *said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *two* Masts and that

her length is *121* feet,  
 her breadth is *21* feet,  
 her depth *10* feet,
