Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Edwin A. Evans

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and jointly with James C. Evans, under the firm of J. C. & E. A. Evans own Fifteen Twentieths (15/20) and that James C. Evans resides at the same place, and owns Four Twentieths (4/20), and that Lyman Hunt resides at the same place, and owns One Twentieth (1/20), and that they are citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Propeller or Vessel called Philadelphia of Buffalo whereof Lyman Hunt is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1868 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 6, 1868 and Numbered 288, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has Two Decks and One Mast and that her length is 226 feet, her breadth is 24 feet, her depth 14 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 1462 Tons and 60 hundredths, viz:
