# ENROLLMENT.

Official Number 16,323. District of Buffalo Creek, Port of Buffalo.

Enrollment in conformity to an Act of the Congress of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA entitled "An Act for enrolling and licensing SHIPS OR VESSELS, &c." passed 18th February, 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N. Y.* and that he is *Secretary of The Western Transportation Company of Tonawanda, N. Y.* and that the said Company own *one half (1/2)* and that *Mr. H. Fargo* resides at the same place, and own *one half (1/2)* and that they are the citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Propeller Vessel called *Mendota* of *Buffalo* whereof *B. A. Root* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or Vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio* in the year *1857* as appears by *the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Aug. 1, 1867, renumbered 269.*

*Now surrendered having changed Owner.* And said Enrollment having certified

that the said Propeller or Vessel has *two* Deck and *one* Mast and that her length is *192* feet, her breadth is *20* feet, her depth *11* feet, her height *10* feet,

and that she measures *785* Tons and *19* hundredths, viz:
